Club Express Mileage Update



Effective October 1st, all rides, recurring and called-in, will be submitted to the Ride Coordinator at RideCoordinator@biketcba.org.

TCBA's Ride Incentive Program

Have you heard of the Ride Incentive Program that TCBA provides? Wonder what the Ride Incentive Program is?

If you are a TCBA member and ride any of the TCBA sponsored Rides (T-Shirt, NorthWest Tour, SummerTour or DALMAC) or any "Member Led Rides" you are eligible for a Ride Incentive! These Ride Incentives vary from year to year, and are based on the number of miles you ride with the TCBA Club. The mission of our club is get members to ride together!

The Level 5 award is for riding up to 500 miles on TCBA sponsored rides.

The Level 4 award is 501-1000 miles

The Level 3 award is 1001 – 1500 miles

The Level 4 award is 1501 to 2015 miles (Level 2 goes up to the current year)

The Level 1 award is for over 2016 (the current year) miles in a riding year (December 1 to November 30)

Typically, TCBA spends \$20, \$40, \$60, \$80, and \$100 respectively, toward the 1-5 Level awards for each Ride Incentive. (A good bargain for your \$10/year membership dues!)

The Ride Incentive Committee (2 Board at Large and at least one other club officer) decide on these awards. Clothing and bicycling safety items are typically what is considered for these awards. (Tax laws prevent TCBA from providing Gift Certificates direct to members in this quantity, and requires the Incentives be

"advertising", i.e., the Club logo.)

In 2015, over 200 TCBA members qualified for the Level 1-5 awards; Last year TCBA provided safety lights to all of the people who earned a Ride Incentive. For the Level 1-4 awards, TCBA also provided SmartWool shirts to about 170 members!

How do can I become eligible for a Ride Incentive? Ride with the club on "Member Led Rides" (go to the biketcba.org website>Event Calendar) to see all the rides listed by TCBA member Ride Leaders. Sign-in on the "Rider Mileage Report" that the Ride Leader provides.

How do I become a Ride Leader? Please go to biketcba.org website, sign into your site, go to "Member Led Rides" and click on the document "Ride Leader and Incentive Program Information" and read this. You will need a "Rider Mileage Report", commonly known as the Rider Sign-in Sheet. Make a route, insure your route is ride-able (many Ride Leaders drive or ride their routes prior), and make cue sheets of the route turns. Make sure that your Ride is publicized on the Event Calendar, by contacting the "Ride Coordinator" (see the Chainwheel Chatter for this e-mail address).

By leading rides, you earn at least 50 miles extra toward your Ride Incentive award. **Questions?** Contact Pat Kelley at president@biketcba.org

DALMAC Treasurer: Detail oriented person needed to take over this function. Doesn't need to be an accountant, but should be detail oriented and computer literate. The current Treasurer has prepared complete documentation for this job. Training will be provided by either the current Treasurer or DALMAC Director.

Media Relations: The person filling this position will compile factual information about the current year's DALMAC and share it with media along the various DALMAC routes. They will also assist in distributing the postcards announcing DALMAC, Summer Tour, and Northwest Tour and preparing the digital brochure each year describing those tours. Documentation is also available for this position.

Stops4U Coordinator: Develop a list of businesses along the DALMAC routes that might interest DALMAC riders (restaurants, grocery stores, pharmacies, bike shops, etc.) Obtain information

for developing this list by contacting local chambers of commerce, DALMAC SAG drivers, DALMAC riders, etc. Organize the list by route and in the route sequence from beginning to end. Contact the businesses/organizations, electronically if possible, prior to DALMAC to inform them that we are coming, what date, and the approximate time frame riders will be in their area so they know what to expect, and or serve.

Since this is a new function, anyone taking on this duty can develop the position as their imagination leads them.

September 2016 Advocacy Committee Report

Recent deaths of Michigan cyclists

- Randy Robertson & Kalamazoo Five Memorial Ride (July 13) – Despite a thunderstorm at the 6 pm start time, about 60 cyclists (including family members and friends) rode in memory of Randy. The State Police allowed us to enter the Capitol Building to escape the storm. We used this new venue to have State Representative Sam Singh and League of Michigan Bicyclists Director John Lindenmayer talk about legislative proposals for a 5-foot safe passing distance and protections for vulnerable users
- Eric Snider—His cycling group staged a memorial ride on August 3.
- September rally to urge the Legislature to pass 5-foot safe passing distance and protections for vulnerable users--The League of Michigan Bicyclists is the prime mover for this event. It will include multiple ghost bikes. It may also have some kind of memorial for Eric Snider.

Letter to the *Lansing State Journal* on Bicycle Fatalities

The TCBA Board approved the following letter which was printed in the LSJ on June 23:

"Cyclists will be safer with clarification of responsibilities"

The Tri-County Bicycle Association thanks LSJ for its Aug. 2 lead article about the recent spate of crashes in which motor vehicles have struck bicyclists who appear to have been riding legally and properly on area roads.

The article captured the grief and fear being felt by area cyclists. The victims of these motorists' alleged negligence are not statistics; they are your neighbors, friends, families and co-workers.

The pain and suffering of their death or injury will endure long after the headlines have faded.

We know the drivers are innocent of negligence unless and until proven guilty. But crashes like these are not "accidents." They have causes: ranging from distracted driving to alcohol abuse to, possibly, outright malice. The Legislature is now considering bills that would clarify motorists' responsibilities with regard to cyclists and increase penalties for negligent motorists who kill or injure cyclists.

Cyclists will be safer when all drivers learn to expect – and thus be on the lookout for – cyclists on our roads and streets.

And when cyclists likewise follow the traffic laws.

Bus Rapid Transit in the Lansing Area

This proposed project for the Michigan/Grand River Avenue corridor in Lansing, East Lansing, and Meridian Township continues to be a hot topic in the area. TCBA's policy on this project is that the Capital Area Transportation Authority and the three governments should abide by the jurisdictions' Complete Streets policies.

Some TCBA members have been asked by CATA and some Meridian Township officials about what cyclists would want with Bus Rapid Transit. The Committee drafted a letter, reviewed by TCBA President Pat Kelley, which contained the following:

- Having cyclists share the BRT lanes with buses
 - Incorporating a bike share component in the BRT project
 - Providing adequate bike parking at the BRT stations
- A subcommittee will begin a dialogue with CATA on our proposal.

The Helmet Update Vol. 34, #5 -- September 1, 2016

Recall of SAHN Classic helmets for failure to meet CPSC

CPSC announced today the recall of SAHN Classic SH523 adult bicycle helmets sold from May 2013 through December 2015 for about \$130.

SAHN is a Vancouver company selling a skate-style helmet in more sophisticated urban trim with a visor.

The helmets have been recalled because they do not meet the impact requirements of the CPSC bicycle helmet standard.

The remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled bicycle helmets and contact SAHN Designs for a free replacement helmet.


TCBA Instructions to update Chainwheel Chatter delivery preference and contact information


